S – SERVANTS - A SHIELD member is one who *“works with enthusiasm, as though you were working for the Lord rather than for people” (Ephesians 6-7)*. A devoted and helpful supporter of TCA will:

- ❖ Help coordinate events and make a difference in TCA.
- ❖ Stay informed.
- ❖ Actively help make TCA the best it can be for their child to learn and be conformed to the image of Jesus Christ.

H – HUMILITY - A SHIELD member is one who *“demonstrates a spirit of humility that is well pleasing before God” (Philippians 2:5)*. You must have the same attitude that Jesus Christ had by:

- ❖ Assisting in discovering answers and discussing opinions on questions he/she may have about their child’s education.
- ❖ Taking an active part in his/her child’s educational environment.

I – INVOLVEMENT – A SHIELD member is one who provides encouragement to the TCA body, *“just as a body, though one, has many parts, but all its many parts form one body, so it is with Christ” (1 Corinthians 12:12)*. When you are involved in SHIELD, YOUR CHILD BENEFITS THE MOST! Become part of the body by:

- ❖ Coordinating fundraisers, which are necessary in providing various programs, activities and incentives for our children.
- ❖ Volunteering for Teacher Appreciation - showing that the teachers are valued through various ways during Teacher Appreciation Week as well as other specified times throughout the school year.
- ❖ Getting to know staff members of TCA.
- ❖ Learning the principles and goals of TCA and the standards of which it is set upon.

E – EXCELLENCE – A SHIELD member is one who encourages TCA to choose what is best, because it will enable us to accomplish what God has designed us to be and do. *“So, my dear brothers and sisters, be strong and immovable. Always work enthusiastically for the Lord, for you know that nothing you do for the Lord is ever useless” (1 Corinthians 15:58)*. We must move in excellence by:

- ❖ Assisting in deciding how to raise funds and distribution.
- ❖ Improving The Church Academy for ALL students.

L – LEADERSHIP – A SHIELD member is one who bears the load for the body of TCA. *“Do not merely look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others” (Philippians 2:4)*. SHIELDS are called to support, protect, and understand the importance of the assignment of being an armor bearer by:

- ❖ Participating in meetings to determine committee leadership, vote on various projects/request, and decide how to best provide resources for the students and teachers.
- ❖ Being an influence in important decisions for TCA.
- ❖ Giving hands on assistance with Student Directory.
- ❖ Creatively encourage teacher’s morale.
